

How does it work?

Habitat for Humanity Pasadena uses volunteer labor and donations to build simple, safe and decent houses. Habitat looks for partner families/individuals who meet our guidelines to partner with for the construction of the house. Once the home is completed, it is sold to the chosen family/individual at a term of 20-30 years with affordable payment amounts based on their income. The homeowners' monthly mortgage payments go back into the fund for Humanity which is used to build more houses.

We do **NOT** help with home remodeling or demolition.

Program Requirements

- Demonstrate a housing need (a need can range from leaking roof, overcrowding, bad neighborhood, etc.)
- Must not qualify for a regular conventional loan
- Anyone who will be living in the home needs to be a citizen or permanent legal resident of the U.S.
- Must have lived in our service area (Pasadena, Galena Park, South Houston, San Jacinto City and Deer Park) for at least one year
- Meets income guidelines based on area median income; (please take a look at the next page to view the income chart)
- Meet credit guidelines we look into your payment history (delinquent/deferred/collection accounts and currently opened accounts) not the credit score.
- Be willing to participate in the Habitat Sweat Equity program (300 volunteer hours)
- Family must give a \$1,500 payment at closing.

If you do not meet all of the qualifications now, there may still be an opportunity for you to apply when your situation changes.

Habitat for Humanity does **NOT** construct on family lots. Habitat for Humanity builds on their own lots; this means families should be willing to relocate.


How do I apply?

- Applicants need to prove they earn sufficient income to be able to pay for the home. They must fall on or either between the expressed limits. If you earn below the minimum or above the cap, we would not be able to partner.
 - Include to your income anyone in the household who is **16 and older** (son, cousin, uncle, friend, etc.) and is **earning money/working.** (SSI, child support, disability, etc.)

How to apply: To begin the application process, please complete this screening questionnaire and return it to our office along with copies of the following documents:

- Completed application, signed and dated by applicant(s).
- Current Driver's License or Texas I.D, or other forms of ID (for applicant and co-applicant)
- Money order (please read last page for amounts)
- Bank Statements (last 6 months) Currently checking and savings accounts
- Social Security Cards for **EVERYONE** who will be living in the household
- Birth certificate for dependents
- Permanent Residence card(if applicable)
- Last two months of pay stubs (for EVERY MEMBER IN THE HOUSE HOLD EARNING INCOME)
- If Self-employed, a year-to-date profit and loss statement
- Your **2022 & 2023** W-2 forms and 1040 's
- Verification of any other source of income and government assistance that the household receives (For example: Child support, SSI/Disability, food stamps, Section 8 housing assistance, etc.)

<u>Note:</u> By completing and submitting this questionnaire to Habitat for Humanity Pasadena, you are beginning the application process. However this questionnaire is not considered a complete application. The questionnaire is simply used to determine whether you might qualify for the program.

Due to the limited number of available lots, not all families that qualify will be approved for a Habitat home.

<u>Next steps:</u> After submitting a questionnaire with **all of the paperwork mentioned above**, Habitat staff will process this information and follow-up with you within 30 days. If something is missing we will leave your application on pending status and not review it until all documents have been submitted.

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Mail or drop off the completed form along with a non-refundable <u>MONEY ORDER</u> for the amount \$45 (Forty-Five) if individually, and \$90 (Ninty) if applying with a co-borrower or married.

• Please note: If money order is not included with the questionnaire, or it is not filled out completely we will not be able to proceed with the assessment process. You will receive a mail response within 30 business days.

If this pre-screening form is not approved, you may re-apply on a later date if your living circumstances or job qualifications change. If you believe you have supplied incorrect information within your form submission, please contact the Habitat for Humanity Pasadena office directly to discuss the matter.

NOTE: All Habitats for Humanity Pasadena Family Partners who get accepted into the home ownership program are required to re-qualify before closing on their home. This process includes re-evaluation of current income, credit report, income tax return, references, and criminal background check.
